

## **THE NORMA HUNT SCHOLARSHIP**

Are you the parent of a child with a disability looking to take up a recognised disability course? The Norma Hunt Scholarship is designed to improve access to education if you are disadvantaged and/or overcoming obstacles/financial hardship to pursue your studies.

A one off scholarship of up to \$500 is being offered towards (1) fees for a recognised disability course at entry level or (2) the purchase of support materials to support your study. You are eligible to apply if you meet the following criteria:

1. Open to parents of a child with a disability, who requires NDIS or ECIS support.
2. Mpower employees, Board and their immediate family members cannot apply.
3. Course must be a recognised disability course.
4. Applicants should be able to articulate their commitment and motivation to the course and area of study in the application.
5. Applicants need to be able to demonstrate financial hardship eg: in receipt of Centrelink. (Disability, Carer Payment, Age or Youth, Austudy, Newstart, Parenting Allowance Single or Partnered, Widows Allowance excluding Child Disability Assistance or Family Tax Benefit)
6. Applications must be lodged by 4pm, 31st January, 2019.
7. The scholarship awardee will be notified by 28<sup>th</sup> February, 2019.
8. Applications are reviewed by The Norma Hunt Scholarship Sub Committee and Mpower Inc. CEO and their decision is final.
9. Proof of payment to verify the purchase of support materials to support your study, if not course fees and proof of enrolment currency will be required to disperse scholarship funds.
